

Dr Alexander Kroll



Dr Kroll is an associate professor of public policy and administration in the Steven J. Green School of International and Public Affairs at Florida International University. He is the department's PhD program director and an associate editor for *Public Performance and Management Review*.

Dr Kroll's research interest is in the management of public organizations and collaborations. This includes topics such as the use of performance practices and data to inform decision-making, leadership, motivation, social capital, and social equity effects of public services. His book *Shared Measures: Collective Performance Data Use in Collaborations* was published by Cambridge University Press. It is about using data to manage diverse teams and draws on a study of opioid-response task forces.

Dr Kroll's work has been cited in President Obama's budget proposal and OMB policy guidance under President Biden. It received awards from the American Society for Public Administration, the Academy of Management, and the European Group of Public Administration. He has engaged in consulting and training with local government managers and employees in South Florida and North Carolina; state agencies in Germany; and groups from Thailand, Tunisia, and Latin America.
