- The consultant should have at least 10 years' experience providing similar services including developing Standard Operating Procedures for PPP Units; 30%
- The consultant should have at least 10 years' experience in developing and successfully executing PPP and Privatisation transactions; experience in structured finance, including hands-on experience in originating, structuring, and executing PPP transactions and structured finance transactions for infrastructure projects; 30%
- Strong project/program management experience; 5%
- International experience working in PPP infrastructure development with knowledge of international best practice trends in PPP assessment, project development and transaction execution process; 20%
- At least 2 years' experience in an English Speaking environment. 5%
