The Government of Jamaica (GOJ) has received a grant through the World Bank (WB) under the Pilot Programme for Climate Resilience (PPCR) toward the cost of implementing the Improving Climate Data and Information Management Project (ICDIMP). The objective is to improve the quality and use of climate related data for effective planning and action at the local and national levels. A portion of the proceeds of this grant will be for a consultant to undertake the Final Evaluation of the ICDIMP.

The objective of this assignment is to assess the performance in terms of relevance and coherence of the project design, efficiency of project implementation, effectiveness in the achievement of the project development objective (PDO) and associated PDO indicators (as measured by the project results framework), project impacts and sustainability.

The Planning Institute of Jamaica now invites eligible individuals to indicate their interest in providing the consultancy services by submitting their curriculum vitae (CV) demonstrating the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the services (description of similar assignments undertaken). The selection criteria are:

- A post-graduate degree in Management, Economics, Development Planning, Project Management, Public Administration or related discipline and at least 5 years' experience in evaluating projects in the areas of environment, natural resources management disaster risk reduction or climate change adaptation; <u>or</u> an undergraduate degree in Management, Economics, Development Planning, Project Management, Public Administration or related discipline with at least 7 years' experience in evaluating projects in the areas of environment, natural resources management, disaster risk reduction or climate change adaptation.
- Experience working with GOJ Ministries, Departments and Agencies.
- Experience working with international development partners in programme evaluation and monitoring; and knowledge of their systems, processes and operations for approving and implementing projects in Jamaica or the Caribbean
- Understanding of climate change issues and their development implications for Jamaica and the Caribbean.
- Excellent report writing skills.
